Emily's story is an example of the amazing changes that are possible with St. Thomas More Catholic Church's tremendous support. *Last year, Emily was laid off from her job and unable to find another one. Emily eventually lost her apartment and found a shelter to stay in but was unable to keep her 13-year-old son with her. This was the first time the two of them had ever been separated. Emily found St. Joseph the Worker, who helped her create a résumé, locate job leads and map out a budget so she would know what kinds of jobs could sustain her small family. St. Joseph the Worker also gave Emily hygiene items, bus tickets to put in applications and professional clothing. Within two months, Emily was hired at a local restaurant and began to receive a regular paycheck. Emily was soon promoted due to her excellent work performance and her savings was enough to move into an apartment. Just 6 months after first becoming homeless, Emily and her son were happily reunited. Today Emily remains employed and she continues to save for the future, which is looking brighter every day.*


