Water Safety Tips

- Learn to swim.
- Learn CPR Post CPR rules by the pool.
- Set water safety rules-post rules by your pool.
- Have a phone by the pool so you can call 9-1-1 if needed.
- Always keep basic lifesaving equipment by the pool and know how to use it.
- Enclose pools with a self-locking, self-closing fence with vertical bars. Openings no more than 4 inches wide. The house should not be part of the barrier. Be very careful of doggie doors - kids go through them easily.
- Keep the pool clean.
- Keep toys away from the pool when it is not in use.
- No furniture near a pool fence kids can climb.
- Always have an adult assigned to watch children.
- Use a feet-first entry when entering water.
- Do not mix alcohol with swimming, diving or boating.
- Never leave a child unattended around any water (bathtub, pool, buckets, etc).
- If a child is missing, check the pool first.
